- (B) The defendant is prohibited from having any contact, direct or indirect with plaintiff,
 - Except contact permitted in paragraph I and/or P below.

- (C) The defendant is prohibited from going upon the premises of the plaintiff's residence.
- (D) The defendant is restrained from, repeatedly and without reasonable cause, stalking or following the plaintiff.
- (E) The defendant is restrained from, repeatedly and without reasonable cause, being at or in the vicinity of the plaintiff's home, school, business or place of employment.
- (F) The defendant is ordered to remove, destroy or return or direct the removal, destruction or return of the private images, cease the dissemination of the private images and is prohibited from any further or future dissemination of the private images.
- (G) The defendant is prohibited from possession of a firearm, muzzle-loading firearm, bow, crossbow or any other dangerous weapon.
